- Subject to any terms imposed by the Australian Grand Prix Corporation (AGPC), all entries must be faxed to our office on (02) 9667 3988 by **Wednesday 17 March 2010** in advance of the 2010 FORMULA 1™ QANTAS Australian Grand Prix .
- Each driver will receive a credential and general admission ticket that are valid for **all four days** of the Event.
- Security is supplied once the event closes each evening. Notwithstanding this, participation in the Auto Salon and the presence of the Vehicle is entirely at Entrant's own risk.
- Displays are strongly encouraged to bring the Hi-Tech scene to the attention of the Grand Prix spectators. Remember this is an outdoor event. Marquees are permitted, provided they are secured safely.

Entrants consent to the use and disclosure of their personal information by AGPC and Auto Salon for the purposes of organising, promoting, marketing and conducting Auto Salon, the Event and subsequent Formula One events, including sending the entrant electronic messages such as email or sms and telephoning the entrant, for an indefinite period.

**2010 FORMULA 1™ QANTAS AUSTRALIAN GRAND PRIX
AUTO SALON – HIGH PERFORMANCE AUTOMOTIVE SHOW - CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION**

Auto Salon is a display of high performance cars to be held at the Formula One event (as defined in the Australian Grands Prix Act 1994 (Vic) (**Act**)) to be held in 2010 (**Event**) at Albert Park (being the 'declared area' and 'designated access areas' as those terms are defined in the Act) (**Albert Park**). Auto Salon is organised by Status Corporation Pty Ltd. Status Corporation may at its discretion accept or reject any entries submitted. Applicants are invited to submit entries for their vehicles in Auto Salon (**Vehicle/s**). Applicants acknowledge that if their application is successful, they will be deemed to be an entrant in the Auto Salon (**Entrant**) and agree to be bound by and comply fully with the following conditions:

1. PROVISION OF VEHICLE AND COMPLIANCE WITH DIRECTIONS

- (a) Entrants must comply with all directions of Status Corporation and/or the Australian Grand Prix Corporation (**AGPC**) and in relation to the time, place and manner of delivery, location, display, movement and removal of the Vehicle and all other aspects (including promotion and advertising) of Auto Salon and the Event. All such matters shall be determined by Status Corporation and AGPC at their discretion.
- (b) Each Entrant warrants that, in respect of any photographs or other material provided to Status Corporation or AGPC pursuant to these Conditions in which copyright or any other intellectual property right subsists (**Work**), the Entrant has the right to authorise, and hereby authorises Status Corporation and AGPC to use and copy the Work at their discretion (and to sub-license others to use and copy the Work), and that any copyright and other intellectual property right, approvals, licences and/or clearances necessary to enable Status Corporation and AGPC to exercise these rights have been duly obtained by the Entrant.
- (c) Status Corporation and AGPC may use an Entrant's image and name and any image or likeness of the Vehicle at its discretion in the promotion of the Event (including without limitation Auto Salon) or any other subsequent Australian Grand Prix.

2. ENTRY AND CREDENTIALS

- (a) Each Entrant shall receive a Vehicle credential enabling entry for a Vehicle to the Event (**Vehicle Credential**) and 2 personal credentials (**Credentials**) (subject to any conditions and restrictions determined at the discretion of AGPC). The Vehicle Credential must be clearly displayed on the Vehicle at all times.
- (b) Use of the Credentials and entry to and presence at the Event is subject to the published Conditions of Sale (available at ticket outlets) and Conditions of Entry displayed at entrances to or within Albert Park (each of which is also displayed at www.grandprix.com.au), the conditions on the reverse of the Credentials, the conditions on the reverse of the Credential Application Form, the Act and any applicable regulations made thereunder, the Parks Victoria Code of Conduct for Contractors Undertaking Works at Albert Park (copy available on request) and all requirements of any authorities with jurisdiction over the activities of AGPC, Albert Park and any facility therein.
- (c) AGPC reserves the right to refuse entry to any Credential holder with reasonable cause and the Credential remains the property of AGPC at all times. If requested by AGPC, Credential holders must surrender the Credential and immediately leave Albert Park by the nearest exit. AGPC may add to, alter or otherwise vary these conditions without notice.

3. LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

- (a) AGPC, Status Corporation, the Minister administering the Australian Grand Prix Act 1994 (Vic), the Minister administering the Crown Land (Reserves) Act 1978 (Vic), the Crown in the right of the State of Victoria, Parks Victoria, State Sport Centres Trust, Kellogg Brown & Root Pty Ltd, the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd, the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile, Formula One Administration Ltd, Formula One Management Ltd, Event sponsors and all other persons involved in the organisation, conduct and promotion of the Event, their respective employees, officers, members, agents, consultants and contractors (**Personnel**) (**Indemnitees**) will not be liable for any loss suffered by the Entrant (or their Personnel) or caused by any acts or omissions of the Indemnitees arising out of or in relation to the Auto Salon or the Event.
- (b) Entrants are responsible for their own property (including the Vehicle(s)), and the Indemnitees will not be liable for loss or damage to any property (including the Vehicle(s) brought to the Auto Salon or the Event).
- (c) Each Entrant indemnifies and must keep indemnified each of the Indemnitees and their respective Personnel against all claims, loss, liability, damage, cost or expense which may be incurred or sustained by any of the Indemnitees or their Personnel arising from any act, matter or thing done, permitted or omitted to be done by the Entrant or its Personnel pursuant to, in default of or in connection with these Conditions.
- (d) Nothing in paragraph 3 of these Conditions affects your rights under the Trade Practices Act 1974 (Cth), Fair Trading Act 1999 (Vic) or similar legislation regarding implied conditions and warranties to the extent that such implied conditions or warranties cannot be excluded by law.

4. LICENCE, REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE

- (a) Any person who drives a vehicle within Albert Park during the Event (**Event Period**) must hold a current Victorian or other recognised driver's licence. All Vehicles must be registered and insured under the Victorian or other recognised vehicle registration and compulsory insurance scheme throughout the Event Period; and
- (b) Entrants must obtain and maintain for the duration of the Event Period, at their own cost, a comprehensive vehicle insurance policy in respect of the Vehicle/s against any liability or loss incurred by the Indemnitees or any third party in relation to any act or omission by the Entrant or his/her agents or representatives or otherwise occurring in respect of the Vehicle. Entrants must provide evidence of such current driver's licence, registration and insurance policy to the satisfaction of AGPC on request.

5. NO SIGNAGE

- (a) No signage or advertising is permitted on or in relation to any Vehicle without the prior written consent of AGPC. Entrants must not advertise, promote, distribute, sell or offer for sale any promotional material, merchandise or other goods or services within Albert Park or in relation to the Event. Without limiting the effect of the foregoing, no signs or other references to tobacco or tobacco-related products may be displayed on or in relation to any Vehicle, facilities or equipment, and Entrants must comply with the Tobacco Advertising Prohibition Act 1992 (Cth) and the Tobacco Act 1987 (Vic) and any other applicable tobacco legislation and regulations, notices and specifications issued thereunder.

6. FILMING, RECORDING AND FOOTAGE

Each entrant acknowledges that:

- (a) It will have no promotional or advertising rights in respect of any sound recording, visual footage or audio-visual footage (in any medium whatsoever) (**Recording**) or any information or other data including official timing, results, performance, telemetry, weather or race control data (**Data**) of, at, or in relation to the Event, including photographic images and any still pictures derived or capable of being derived from a Recording (Image) of the Event and acknowledges that such rights vest only with AGPC, FIA or FOA or any one or more of them;
- (b) Where entitled to do so, AGPC may in its absolute discretion grant to any other person or corporation any right, title, licence and interest in any of the Image or Recording;
- (c) If the Entrant acquires any right, title or interest at any time in any of the Recording, Data or Image, the Entrant must not in any way use the right, title or interest and must immediately assign it to AGPC or any such nominee at no charge to AGPC or any such nominee; and (d) the Entrant must not make, create, store, record, transmit, reproduce or use (or authorise the making, creating, storing, recording, transmission, reproduction or use of) any form of Recording or Image, and must not store, record, transmit, reproduce or use any Data, of, at or in relation to the Event or of any cars, drivers teams, persons or activities present or situated within Albert Park for any form of public advertisement, transmission, display, or for profit or commercial gain or for any other purpose (except for the private enjoyment of the person making the Recording, Data or Image) except with the prior permission of AGPC, FOM and/or FOA in its (or their) absolute discretion.
